NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the St. John the Baptist Parish Council, that Parish President Jaclyn Hotard is hereby duly authorized and empowered on behalf of the St. John the Baptist Parish Council to execute Change Order No. 2 between St. John the Baptist Parish and Foret Contracting Group, LLC. The motion passed with Councilwoman Schnyder abstaining.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the St. John the Baptist Parish Council, acting as Governing Authorizing of St. John the Baptist Parish SECTION 1. That the St. John the Baptist Parish Council does hereby authorize the Parish President to complete and submit those documents and agreements required in connection with the Community Water Enrichment Fund (CWEF) 2021-2022 grant application totaling \$150,000.00 to the State of Louisiana for the Waterline Improvements on Cardinal Street in LaPlace and Carol Street in Pleasure Bend. The motion passed unanimously.
