EMERGENCY DECLARATION


WHEREAS, Tropical Storm Ida has the potential to cause extensive flood & wind damage in St. John the Baptist Parish; and
WHEREAS, there is a considerable amount of uncertainty with the meteorological conditions; and
WHEREAS, immediate emergency actions are required to minimize the effects of the Tropical System; and
WHEREAS, the area involved needs emergency actions and support to respond to the Tropical System; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that I, Jaclyn Hotard, Parish President of St. John the Baptist Parish, by authority vested in me by the Home Rule Charter and ordinances of St. John the Baptist Parish, the Louisiana Emergency Assistance and Disaster Act of 2006, and any other acts which may prevail, do hereby proclaim

A STATE OF EMERGENCY

to exist in St. John the Baptist Parish and that all Emergency Operations Plans be activated and that the St. John the Baptist Parish, Department of Public Safety, Office of Emergency Preparedness and Homeland Security be hereby designated as point of contact.

THIS EMERGENCY DECLARATION ISSUED ON THIS 27th DAY OF AUGUST 2021, AND EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY AT TIME OF ISSUANCE.
