22-29 (Public Hearing Held) An ordinance approving the re-subdivision of Lot A, Section B, Reine Subdivision into Lots 1A & 2A, Section B, Reine Subdivision located in the area generally bounded by the Y & MV Railroad, McReine Road, Marcia Street, and Highway 3217, LaPlace, St. John the Baptist Parish, LA, as shown in Exhibit 1 attached (PZS-22-1310) (J. Hotard & T. Lambeth)

A Resolution authorizing St. John the Baptist Parish to award the bid to Thermoplastic (TPO) or Modified Bitumen Roof Hurricane Ida Disaster Repairs to FCA Construction, LLC. WHEREAS, Article IV, Section H (2) and (5) of the St. John the Baptist Parish Home Rule Charter permits the Parish Council to adopt a resolution when authorizing a designated person(s) to execute a previously approved contract on its behalf and/or to perform a ministerial act related to the administrative business of the Parish; and WHEREAS, FCA Construction, LLC. of Harahan, LA submitted the lowest responsive and responsible bid in the amount of \$375,650; and, WHEREAS, as a result of damages sustained by Hurricane Ida, six (6) buildings with TPO or Modified Bitumen Roofing throughout the Parish are in need of repairs; and, WHEREAS, costs of repairs will be funded

through the Hurricane Ida Fund with FEMA reimbursement. **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** by the St. John the Baptist Parish Council, that St. John the Baptist Parish is hereby authorized to award the bid for Thermoplastic (TPO) or Modified Bitumen Roof Hurricane Ida Disaster Repairs to FCA Construction, LLC. The motion passed with Councilman Torres absent.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the St. John the Baptist Parish Council, that Parish President Jaclyn Hotard is hereby duly authorized and empowered on behalf of the St. John the Baptist Parish Council to execute Change Order No. 1 between St. John the Baptist Parish and FCA Construction, LLC. WHEREAS, Article IV, Section H (2) and (5) of the St. John the Baptist Parish Home Rule Charter permits the Parish Council to adopt a resolution when authorizing a designated person(s) to execute a previously approved contract on its behalf and/or to perform a ministerial act related to the administrative business of the Parish; and WHEREAS, Change Order No. 1 increases the original contract dated May 10, 2022, by \$14,866.62 and adds an additional 30 calendar days: and, WHEREAS, additional costs are due to damages sustained by Hurricane Ida that were unforeseen before repairs began; and, WHEREAS, Change Order No. 1 will be funded through the Hurricane Ida Fund with FEMA reimbursement. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the St. John the Baptist Parish Council, that Parish President Jaclyn Hotard is hereby duly authorized and empowered on behalf of the St. John the Baptist Parish Council to execute Change Order No. 1 between St. John the Baptist Parish and Veterans Construction, LLC. The motion passed with Councilman Torres absent.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the St. John the Baptist Parish Council, that Parish President, Jaclyn Hotard is hereby duly authorized and empowered on behalf of the St. John the Baptist Parish Council to sign and execute the Professional Services Agreement between St. John the Baptist Parish and Meyer Engineers, LTD. The motion passed with Councilman Torres absent.

WHEREAS, Article IV, Section H (2) and (5) of the St. John the Baptist Parish Home Rule Charter permits the Parish Council to adopt a resolution when authorizing a designated person(s) to execute a previously approved contract on its behalf and/or to perform a ministerial act related to the administrative business of the Parish; and WHEREAS, McKim & Creed, Inc. of Gonzales, LA has been selected as the Engineer for the Reserve Wastewater Treatment Pond Capacity Expansion Project; and, WHEREAS, to consolidate four (4) existing Regional Wastewater Treatment Plants on the East bank, the Reserve Wastewater Treatment Pond capacity needs to be expanded from 5 MGD to 12 MGD to treat additional flow; and, WHEREAS, the estimated cost of the Agreement is \$1,276,552.92 and will be funded through the Wastewater Fund with reimbursement from the Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality Clean Water State Revolving Loan and/or the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Funds. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the St. John the Baptist Parish Council, that Parish President, Jaclyn Hotard is hereby duly authorized and

empowered on behalf of the St. John the Baptist Parish Council to sign and execute the Professional Services Agreement between St. John the Baptist Parish and McKim & Creed, Inc. The motion passed unanimously.
