WHEREAS, Article [V, Section H (2) and (5) of the St. John the Baptist Parish Home Rule Charter permits the Parish Council to adopt a resolution when authorizing a designated person(s) to execute a previously approved contract on its behalf and/or to perform a ministerial act related to the administrative business of the Parish; and WHEREAS, St. John the Baptist Parish has submitted an application for funding under the CDBG-DR Infrastructure Program; and, WHEREAS, the Department of Housing & Urban Development regulations require that St. John the Baptist Parish certify that these activities for which CDBG Funds are being requested are designed to alleviate existing conditions which pose a serious and immediate threat to the health or welfare of the community, which are of recent origin or which recently became urgent, and that St. John the Baptist Parish is unable to commit local funding for the activity on its own, and that no other funds are available; and, WHEREAS, St. John the Baptist Parish Council previously approved the commitment of Parish funds in the amount of \$549,060.67 for the Vicknair Canal Pump Station; and, NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the St. John the Baptist Parish Council, that St. John the Baptist Parish hereby certifies that the activities for which CDBG Funds are being requested for the Vicknair Canal Pump Station Project are designed to alleviate existing conditions which pose a serious and immediate threat to the health or welfare of the community; are of recent origin or which recently became urgent and that St. John the Baptist Parish is unable to commit local funding for the activity on its own, and there are no other funds available. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the St. John the Baptist Parish Council does hereby authorize the Parish President to execute any and all documents in connection with an application to the Louisiana Office of Community Development for an increased request of total Parish funding in the amount of \$270.00 for the Vicknair Canal Pump Station Project to bring the total Parish commitment to \$549,330.67. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the St. John the Baptist Parish Council, that St. John the Baptist Parish hereby adopts the Urgent Need Resolution as required by CDBG-DR Infrastructure Program. WHEREAS, Article IV, Section H (2) and (5) of the St. John the Baptist Parish Home Rule Charter permits the Parish Council to adopt a resolution when authorizing a designated person(s) to execute a previously approved contract on its behalf and/or to perform a ministerial act related to the administrative business of the Parish; and WHEREAS, this resolution authorizes the Parish President to suspend the acceptance of new applications for resubdivision and/or rezoning by the Parish Government, or a third-party on its behalf, until such time as the Parish Council decides whether to impose a moratorium on the same, pursuant to authority granted in Article IV, Section H (5) - Resolutions - of the St. John the Baptist Parish Home Rule Charter. WHEREAS, the Parish President is the chief executive officer of the Parish and is responsible for the administration, direction, and supervision of all Parish departments and officers, in accordance with Article III, Section B (3)(a) - Powers and Duties - of the St. John the Baptist Parish Home Rule Charter; and WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Department, established pursuant to Article III, Section C (4) - Planning and Zoning - of the St. John the Baptist Parish Home Rule Charter, is responsible for accepting, processing and presenting applications for "Change of Zoning District" and/or resubdivision to the Planning Commission and Parish Council for consideration; and WHEREAS, the responsibility for the administration, direction, and supervision of the Planning and Zoning Department rests with the Parish President. NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the St. John the Baptist Parish Council, that the Parish President is hereby duly authorized and empowered to suspend the acceptance of new applications for resubdivision and/or "Change of Zoning District", until such time as the Parish Council decides whether impose a moratorium on the same.
