APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Mr. Fraker requested a motion regarding the minutes of August 3, 2022.

MOTION: Ms. Mathieu motion to approve, second by Mr. Maurin - Unanimously approved.

Director's Report (If applicable) - None

Dr. Lambeth stated there isn't a report but updates on projects and CUP (Coastal Use Permit) updates regarding comments, etc. Dr. Lambeth welcomed and introduced Mr. Jon Troxillo with the Louisiana Department of Natural Resources, office of Coastal Management, and advised he will give a presentation on the CUP process.

NEW BUSINESS

LDNR Presentation on CUP (Coastal Use Permit) Process

Mr. Truxillo greeted everyone and introduced members of his staff: Sara Krupa, Coastal Resource Scientist Mgr.-Interagency Affairs, and Mark Hogan Coastal Resource Scientist Supervisor - Interagency Affairs. The committee welcomed all.

Mr. Truxillo presented a slide show - Louisiana Department of Natural Resources Office of Coastal Management (Attachment 1). Mr. Truxillo explained the SONRIS – The LDNR Strategic On-Line Natural Resource Information System, adding that this is a sophisticated system. Mr. Truxillo advised the Permitting Department works with local government such as St. John. He advised Louisiana's Principal Coastal Permitting Agencies such as the Corp of Engineers works with wetlands, canals, and other natural waterways. They also serve as a clearing house – Public Notices. He discussed the Coastal Use Permit and the efforts regarding conditions that protect the coastal environment. Mr. Truxillo also discussed the Coastal Wetlands Planning, Protection and Restoration Act (CWPPRAthe Breaux act of 1990) and restoration efforts. Interagency Affairs and Field Services Division was discussed. Mr. Truxillo stated these matters are usually not turned over to the parish and gave example as the Oil spill Section. Mr. Truxillo went on to discuss the Louisiana Coastal Management Program examples of Parishes with Coastal Zone Programs such as St. John and assist with field services. Ms. Mathieu inquired about CWIPPRA comments. Dr. Lambeth advised St. John comments as a committee. Further discussion continued regarding CUP comments. Mr. Truxillo advised all comments go through Dr. Lambeth and she will forward to DNR. Mr. Truxillo also advised that Dr. Lambeth's comments are reviewed quarterly and given substantial consideration. Dr. Lambeth encouraged input from the committee. Mr. Truxillo inquired about the Coastal Zone Committee and the way it is set up. Ms. Cornman advised each member represents a specific group, as the oil industry, citizens, etc. She advised there are three (3) vacancies at present regarding commercial fishing, recreational fishing, and floodplain management. Mr. Truxillo commended St. John for their efforts with this program.
